





# RIVET COUNTER HO SCALE BSC F68BH FINGER RACK FLATCAR

Our **Rivet Counter™** brand strives to create the most accurately detailed model trains imaginable. The real-world counterpart is meticulously researched to ensure prototype fidelity. Each model features numerous factory applied parts including **railroad**, **road number**, and **era-specific™** details whenever possible.

In 1969, Bethlehem Steel Co. (BSC) introduced a new generation of high-capacity flats called the F68-series. These flats were 100-ton and 68 feet long (over end sills). They were extremely versatile and could be equipped with various appliances from the factory to handle different loadings. In 1969, BSC introduced a new class of cars for Trailer Train known as the "F68BH" class.

The F68BH cars had steel decks, transverse deck risers, and a MacLean-Fogg transverse tie-down apparatus. They also had upright "finger racks" near each end, which helped secure their intended lading of concrete reinforcing bar, or "rebar." Due to their distinctive finger racks, these flats became known as "candelabra cars."

The 100-ton cars came equipped with 36" wheels, trucks with hydraulic snubbers at opposite corners, and 15" EOCC to improve ride quality and reduce dangerous shifting loads. Between December 1969 and February 1970, BSC built 150 F68BH cars. Initially, these cars were used for rebar service out of Bethlehem Steel's Steelton, PA facility and could be seen hauling rebar nationwide.




